Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to the official respondents to decide his representation (P-1) and further taking legal action against the private respondents for committing fraud.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, is directed to look into representation dated 11.07.2018 (P-1) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, to look into the grievances

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unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 11.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take an appropriate action by passing a speaking order, after giving a patient hearing to the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
