By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions for decision on his representation dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure P-3).

The learned counsel submits that although he was inducted as a tenant in the premises owned by one Salwinder Singh @ Chhinda and has been regularly paying the rent but said Salwinder Singh @ Chhinda wants to forcibly dispossess him and that on 2.6.2018 Salwinder Singh @ Chhinda and Sube Singh alongwith other members of their family forcibly entered into the shop and threw all the articles outside the shop in order to forcibly dispossess him. It has been submitted that although a representation dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3) dated 4.6.2018, moved by the petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations

levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-3) dated 4.6.2018 be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
