Prayer in this application is for issuance of a direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of the matter expeditiously in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the main petition, at this stage and face trial.

With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, hearing of this petition is preponed from 14.08.2018 for today itself.

It is not in dispute that the co-accused Dharamjit Singh, husband of the deceased was convicted by the learned trial Court on 15.11.2013 (Annexure P-4). All the other co-accused were acquitted by the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. The petitioner was afforded opportunity to appear before the learned trial Court on 16.05.2016 and he was ordered to be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the

learned Court. The co-accused Dharamjit Singh, has since been passed away as well. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has thereafter been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. He undertakes to face the trial and at this stage, he seeks to withdraw this petition.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has already appeared before the learned trial Court pursuant to order dated 06.05.2016, passed by this Court, prayer for setting aside order dated 03.06.2011, is rendered infructuous.

Application is disposed of and the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas as may be available to him before the learned trial Court.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the trial in this case be concluded within six months from receipt of certified copy of this order.
