The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation/complaint dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P/1) lodged by petitioner No.1 against respondent No.5 expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against Sital Singh @ Jasbir @ Sonu son of Santokh Singh, who is the main person involved. Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the representation/complaint should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. APS Gill, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the

representation of the petitioners within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 17.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
