This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102, dated 22.09.2017 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 01.12.2017.

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 22.09.2017, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she had accepted money from the complainant for getting government job for his daughter. He further contends that the petitioner is 63 years old house-wife and is not in a position to promise a government job. He also contends that the allegations are primarily against the main accused Nachhattar Singh.

Issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 19.01.2018.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation.

In the event of her arrest, the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on ad-interim bail subject to his/her satisfaction. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and she shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Mohinder Singh informs the Court that petitioner has since joined investigation.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 01.12.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
