ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.371 dated 24.04.2018 registered under Sections 363/368, 370, 120-B IPC at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, District Panipat.

This is second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail. Counsel for the petitioner contends that the first bail application was withdrawn and the copy of the order is annexed as Annexure P-2. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is seeking parity as two persons, who are the main accused, have been allowed bail by this Court. Counsel refers to Annexure P-3.

Two girls were missing. No complaint was lodged by the mother. Another girl went missing and the FIR was lodged. The girls were never recovered. The petitioner is accused of conspiracy with Kusum. The

allegations are that the petitioner had suffered a disclosure statement and had shared the amount received by them.

Admittedly, the girls have not been recovered. Investigation is already over and challan has been filed and bail had been allowed to Kusum, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on the ground of parity on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
