The petitioner has filed the present petition for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.115, dated 05.11.2014, registered under Sections 21/ 22/ 61/ 85 of NDPS Act & 25/ 54/ 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

Initially the petitioner moved an application for grant of interim bail which was rejected by learned Additional Sessions Judge on 14.11.2017. Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail as interim bail was till the receipt of Chemical Examiner Report. Now the report has been received and finding the alleged recovery to be commercial, the petitioner was taken into custody. The petitioner should have approached the trial Court for grant of regular bail as earlier petition was for interim bail as Chemical Examiner Report was not received at the time of presentation of the challan.

Without availing the remedy of moving application before the

trial Court, the petitioner has approached this Court.

Dismissed.

However, petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy before the trial Court.
