Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Kishan submits that material witnesses have already been examined. 30.01.2018 is the next date and in all probability, the trial may be concluded within a period of three months.

2 kg 600 grams of opium was allegedly recovered from the petitioner.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, the weight of the contraband was inclusive of weight of the polythene and therefore, being marginally excess than the prescribed limit of 2.5 kg, the petitioner deserves to be enlarged on regular bail.

Keeping in view the stage of the case particularly when all the material witnesses have been examined, I deem it appropriate to direct the trial Court to conclude the trial preferably within three months from the date already fixed i.e. 30.01.2018.
