Short affidavit of Sarabjit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, on behalf of respondent-State filed in Court today is taken on record.

Heard.

It comes out that FIR in question was registered on 24.3.2017 on the basis of a secret information wherein several persons were named by involving in the business of selling the intoxicant substance. Petitioner was one of those persons named in the FIR.

Vide order dated 12.11.2018, State was directed to file an affidavit as to what evidence has been collected against the petitioner.

In the affidavit filed by the State today, there is no mention as to what evidence has been collected and there is only a suspicion against the petitioner that he is indulging in sale of intoxicant substance. There is no recovery of narcotic from the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation. Nothing incriminating has come against the petitioner so far.

In view of the matter, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.11.2018 is made absolute with liberty to the State that if any such evidence comes against the petitioner subsequently, State shall be entitled to move for cancellation of the bail.

Petition stands allowed.
