AVNEESH JHINGAN, J.

This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been moved by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 90 dated 14.10.2017, under Sections 407, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

This Court, on 2.12.2017, passed the following order:

“In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned States counsel, on instructions from ASI Magar Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the statement of the learned State counsel, the order dated 2.12.2017 is made absolute. The petitioner to file regular bail bonds before the learned trial Court on presentation of challan.

The petition is allowed.
