Present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of the Criminal Complaint No. 149-1 dated 19.04.2011, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC pending before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar (Annexure P-5), the order of summoning dated 04.02.2012 (Annexure P-6), the order in revision dated 18.12.2014 (Annexure P-7) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for petitioner No.2 submits that petitioner No.1-Ramesh Mohan Malik has since expired on 16.07.2018. Counsel for petitioner No.2 further submits that the main trial of the case itself has been concluded and the accused has been acquitted of the charge. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
