The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0076 dated 28.08.2017, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Petitioner No. 1 is the son-in-law of the deceased and petitioner No. 2 is his brother. The allegations are that the deceased committed suicide on account of the fact that his daughter was being harassed by the petitioners and that the harassment was on account of the fact that petitioner No. 1 was having an affair with his sister-in-law (Bhabhi) and petitioner No. 2 and other members of the family were harassing her for bringing inadequate dowry.

Learned State counsel submits that the investigation is complete and that the challan has already been presented. Charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the fact that the investigation is complete, it would be appropriate and in the interest of justice to grant regular bail to the petitioners. The petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their

furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
