Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been
made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.147 dated
03.11.2017 registered under Sections 406,420 and 506 read with Section 34
IPC at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that compromise has
arrived at between the complainant and the petitioner. Therefore, they have
