The petitioners have filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of official respondents especially respondents No.3 and 4.

Surprisingly, before filing the present petition, the petitioners have not made any representation to respondent No.2 Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa and have straightway approached this Court. Therefore, this Court finds that the present petition is not maintainable. However, in case the petitioners submit such like representation within a week from today, it is expected that the respondent No.2 shall take note of the same and shall act in accordance with law.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
