The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a complaint bearing No. 0000039/2016 dated 16.07.2016 titled as 'Pawan Lal vs. Surinder Pal' registered under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Vide order dated 12.12.2018, the petitioner had been directed to appear before the trial Court and the trial Court had been directed to grant ad-interim bail on putting his appearance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to medical reasons the petitioner has been unable to comply with this order.

However, learned counsel for respondent No. 2 states that the petitioner did not intentionally appeared as he had been declared proclaimed offender in one more case.

Whatever may be the reason for non-appearance, the fact remains that the petitioner has failed to comply with the order passed by this Court and, thus, has misused the indulgence shown by this Court. He is, therefore, not entitled to any

For the above reasons, the present petition is dismissed.

If so advised, the petitioner may still appear before the trial Court, and apply for bail. If such an application is moved, the trial Court shall decide his application sympathetically .
