Petitioner Pritam Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.6 dated 14.01.2018, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for respondent No.2 appeared in this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the compromise has already been effected between the parties and has no objection, if this petition is allowed.

In pursuance of interim order dated 23.10.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required

for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending

him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the compromise effected between the parties; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 23.10.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
