The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0066 dated 25.8.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 436, 427, 148, 149, 120-B, 188 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") read with Section 3 & 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 & 4 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the co-accused has already been granted the benefit of regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that the total damage was to the tune of ₹ 1,05,000/-.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners-Jasvir Singh @ Sira son of

Baldev Singh @ Dev Singh, Tarsem Singh @ Kala son of Baldev Singh @ Dev Singh and Buta Singh son of Gurdev Singh @ Gora Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of their absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
