Petitioners Rajwinder Kaur and Paramjit Singh have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who are parents and other relatives of petitioner No.1. Petitioner No.1 is aged 17 years as informed by petitioner No.2 in his affidavit annexed with the petition while petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of his Aadhar Card indicating that he is aged 23 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran to look into the representation dated 21.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties and shall not be deemed to confer any immunity upon petitioners from any action warranted under law for having married before the marriageable age.
