This order shall dispose of three petitions bearing Nos. CRM-

482 Cr.P.C. for quashing FIR No.117, dated 16.05.2014, registered at P.S. City Khanna, District Ludhiana, under Section 406/420/120-B IPC.

3. Briefly, the case of the prosecution is that the petitioners and the co-accused Sonu Chauhan, Pankaj Arya, Harmanprit Singh Arora defrauded the complainant of a sum of ₹10 lacs on the pretext of sending him and his family to United Kingdom.

4. The matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise deeds dated 28.01.2015, 12.02.2015 and 23.11.2016 respectively (Annexure P-2) .

5. Notice of motion was issued in all the petitions and the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court vide order dated 29.09.2017 (passed in CRM-M-36415-2017) and get their statements recorded. In pursuant to the said order, complainant-respondent No.2 had put in appearance through counsel, however, he is not represented today.

6. Report dated 01.11.2017 (in CRM-M-36415-2017) has been received, according to which the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and has been entered into without any threat or coercion. Moreover, the statement of complainant-respondent No.2 was also recorded in which he has admitted the genuineness of the compromise.

7. Under the circumstances, the above petitions are allowed and FIR No.117, dated 16.05.2014 under Section 406/420/120-B IPC, registered at P.S. City Khanna, District Ludhiana, along with other consequential proceedings thereunder is hereby quashed so far as the petitioners are concerned.

8. A copy of this order be placed on the file of other connected petitions.
