The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to expedite the trial in case FIR No.69 dated 08.02.2015, registered under Sections 287, 337, 338, 34 IPC, at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat and conclude it as early as possible within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raj Kumar Makkad, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Complete copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Service is complete.

This is a case where trial has been kept pending and delay has been caused unnecessarily. The record of the trial court transpires that the witnesses did not turn up before the trial court.

In view of above, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the concerned Investigating Officer to produce the entire prosecution witnesses for examination on the date fixed before the trial court. In failure to do so, then the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Sonipat, District Sonipat shall personally appear before that court and submit the explanation for non-production of the witnesses. The trial court is directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
