The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Jyoti, in case FIR No.170 dated 29.12.2013 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 of Immoral Traffic Act (for short 'the Act'), 1956 at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana City, in which offences under Sections 419, 177, 182 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') were added later on and in which the police has filed report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 of the Act read with Sections 419, 177, 182 IPC .

It has been submitted that petitioner is in custody since 01.09.2018.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety to the

satisfaction of the learned trial/Duty Magistrate and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
