The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 38 dated 30.04.2018, under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala.

The operative part of the order dated 25.10.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the real sister of the petitioner – Baljinder Kaur was married to deceased – Sucha Ram about 08 years ago and out of this wedlock, they had two children. It is further submitted that due to the maltreatment given by the deceased – Sucha Ram, the sister of the petitioner – Baljinder Kaur left her matrimonial home and is still missing since 24.04.2018. Counsel for the petitioner has also argued that later on, the deceased – Sucha Ram committed suicide and there are no such allegation against the petitioner that immediately before committing the offence, the petitioner has abetted in a manner that forced Sucha Ram to commit suicide. Notice of motion for 04.12.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 25.10.2018, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Raghuvir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 25.10.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
