Complainant Pulkit son of late Satish got this FIR No.286 dated 26.6.2018, registered under Sections 307, 341, 427 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC, Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh, against accused Satnam Singh (petitioner) and co-accused Jasbir Singh.

It is alleged that the assailants attacked the complainant as he was roaming around their house after entering into marriage with their sister. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 26.6.2018.

Reply by way of affidavit of Shri Ranjit Singh, Station House Officer, Manimajra (U.T.), Chandigarh has been filed by learned State counsel in Court. Same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the

counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Investigation is complete and challan stands submitted. The injury attributed to the petitioner is on the right arm and the second injury suffered by the victim is attributed to Jasbir Singh i.e. on the left arm. It is not in dispute that the co-accused Jasbir Singh is already on regular bail and the injury attributed to the petitioner is grievous.

The trial is likely to take some time and no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. Without commenting anything upon merits of the case and considering the custody and status of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Satnam Singh is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
