DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.55, dated 04.03.2017, registered under Sections 307/ 323/ 324/ 325/ 326/ 427/ 148/ 149 IPC & 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case and the injuries which have been attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature. Out of total four accused three have been found innocent. Petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2017. The investigation has been completed and challan has been presented. The charges have not been framed so far. The trial of the case would take long time to conclude and no purpose would be served to keep the petitioner behind the bars.

Learned State counsel has opposed the submissions made by

learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that three more cases are pending against the petitioner out of which in one case he is on bail and he is a habitual offender.

By considering that the petitioner is in custody since 26.07.2017, the challan has been presented and the injuries which have been attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature; the earlier petition was dismissed and this petition has been filed after undergoing more custody period; that challan has also been presented and that the trial will take long time to conclude and that no purpose would be served to keep the petitioner behind the bars, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
