Petitioners have preferred this petition for pre-arrest bail as the trial court issued non-bailable warrants due to their non-appearance before it. At the time of issuance of notice of motion, it was directed that in case petitioners surrender before the trial court within 15 days of the order, they would be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the court. It has been submitted today that petitioners have put in appearance before the trial court and are on interim bail at present. This contention is not controverted by counsel representing the respondents.

In view of above, interim order dated 5.12.2017 is hereby made absolute. Petition stands allowed. Trial court shall, however, be at liberty to impose such conditions on the petitioners as deemed necessary keeping in view their non-appearance on earlier dates despite summons/warrants issued by the court.
