One Pawan Kumar, committed suicide leaving a suicide note wherein he alleged that he had taken a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- from Sandeep Kumar, and Channi, dealer. They have converted those Rs. 10,00,000/- into Rs. 20,00,000/-. He also levelled allegations against one Sandeep Kumar and Pawan Kumar. During investigation, it came out that there was an agreement of sale by Meena Sharma wife of Pawan Kumar (deceased) in favour of petitioner. Petitioner has already filed a civil suit, in which stay has been granted. It is for this reason that petitioner has also been arrayed as co accused for offence under Section 306 IPC. Petitioner was arrested on 26.10.2017 and in this case, one of witnesses has already been examined and other witness has been given up. Material witnesses have already been examined. In similar circumstances, co accused Charanjit Singh was granted regular bail by this Court, vide order 18.9.2018, passed in CRM-M-39632-2018.

In these circumstances, there is no ground for further detention of petitioner. Petition is accordingly allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of like amount to satisfaction of trial Court, subject to conditions, as may be imposed by trial Court.
