Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent No.1 to hand over/entrust the investigation in FIR No.101 dated 07.04.2017 under Sections 323, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Parao, Ambala Cantt. to some independent agency other than Ambala Police and preferably to CBI.

Reply by Ms. Nitika Gahalaut, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Ambala, has already been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Krishan Pal states that apart from the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, even in the said FIR, accused have been acquitted vide judgment dated 01.08.2018.

Though this fact was required to be brought to the notice of this

Court by the petitioner, but since counsel for the petitioner has not come present and accused has been acquitted, no further action is required in the case.

In view of the stand so taken by learned State Counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
