The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 275 dated 10.7.2018, under Sections 323, 354, 452, 506 IPC and Section 354-B 376/511 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is argued that the material witness i.e. prosecutrix has been examined and out of 14 witnesses only one has been examined. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana has contested the bail application, while submitting that the offence allegedly committed by the petitioner is of serious nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the material witness has been examined and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
