Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the instant petition had been filed seeking cancellation of bail, allowed to respondent No.2 Vipul Mittal in case FIR No. 523 dated 06.11.2015 under Sections 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 34, South Chandigarh.

It is contended that during the integrum the charges so framed, have been changed to charge under Section 302 IPC. It is submitted that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. He seeks liberty to challenge the bail granted to respondent No.2 Vipul Mittal under Section 302 IPC in the said FIR.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
