Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.4 dated 03.01.2011 under Sections 279, 323, 379, 427, 506 & 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 06.12.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 30 days, for recording their statements. Thereafter, on 25.01.2018, the time was extended on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner as the parties could not appear before the trial Court. Again a report dated 21.03.2018 has been received that none of the parties have appeared before the trial Court for recording their statements.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed as infructuous, at this stage. However, it will be open for the parties to file a fresh petition, in case, the parties still acknowledge the compromise.
