Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 309 dated 15.12.2017, registered under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 05.02.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Madan Lal has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation. State counsel further says that challan has been presented and the case is fixed for framing of charge.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 05.02.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
