Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 364 dated 20.12.2017, registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 324, 308 IPC (added later on) at P.S. Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

The alleged occurrence took place in front of liquor vend where birthday of complainant was being celebrated. The allegations are that the petitioner along with others also arrived there. On account of some altercation, occurrence took place in which Suraj, Dinesh Mandal, Sanjiv and the complainant allegedly received injuries at the hands of the accused party. The injury on the person of Suraj was found to be covered under Section 308 IPC and the said injury was attributed to co-accused Atul. Co-accused Puneet Sharma has already been granted bail

by this Court in CRM-M No. 2765 of 2018 vide order dated 29.1.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parvinder Singh, though opposed the bail, but could not distinguish the case of the petitioner from the case of co-accused Puneet Sharma, who has been granted regular bail by this Court.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.12.2017. Trial is likely to take sometime in its culmination.

In view of above, without adverting to the merits of the case, it will be just and expedient to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Let the petitioner be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
