Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.78 dated 11.08.2018 under Sections 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 25.10.2018: -

“.....Counsel for the petitioner submits that while granting interim anticipatory bail to the co-accused on 18.09.2018 in CRM-M No.41050 of 2018, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR has been registered on account of a dispute, which occurred due to playing of DJ on high volume. It is further submitted that no one was injured in the case and no MLR of any

person was recorded.

Notice of motion for 25.10.2018.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Dilbagh Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
