The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of a direction to official respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to take appropriate action on the complaint/ representation of the petitioners dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the representation dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 & 3. Three copies of the petition be handed over to her by learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of the day failing which no

action is called for. She submits that the representation dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) will be decided within a period of six weeks.
