Learned counsel for the respondent/complainant submits that his client at this stage is not agreeable to get the sale deed executed in his favour from the petitioner, in view of the petitioner's past conduct. Learned counsel also submits that petitioner is involved in five other cases of the similar nature on account of which he should not be allowed the concession of bail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State submits that after completion of investigation the *challan* against the present petitioner was presented on 22.12.2015, which is more than 2 years ago.

In these circumstances there is no justification to detain the petitioner during pendency of trial in the present case.

He may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, Ambala.
