Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 26.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and this fact has been affirmed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh.

However, learned State counsel has opposed bail of the petitioner on the ground that as per FSL, the recovery is commercial.

By considering the allegations levelled against the petitioner; and that his name is not mentioned in the FIR; he has been implicated on the basis of statement made by co-accused; recovery has already been effected; there is no other case under the NDPS Act against him and also the fact that he has joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.10.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
