Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 94 dated 31.10.2017 under Sections 406/498A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 17.04.2018. Settlement/agreement dated 17.04.2018 is attached with this file. It is submitted that the petitioner and his wife – the complainant have resumed cohabitation. Both of them are living in peace and harmony in the matrimonial home alongwith their children. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, verifies that the petitioner and his wife are residing together. On instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, it is verified that the petitioner has joined investigation. He is not reported to be involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 06.12.2017 is made absolute.
