ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail. The first bail application had been dismissed on 13.08.2018.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the date of custody noted in the order is not correct and the petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2017. Counsel further submits that statement of the father has also been recorded and he had admitted that there were differences between him and his wife and that is the reason the daughter had committed suicide. Counsel has shown the copy of the statement.

I find no such statement was made by the victim's father. He had denied that there was any discord between the two. A reading of the statements also shows that the mother of the deceased had earlier died.

The petitioner is a married man who had promised marriage to the girl. The complainant had approached the petitioner for training of her brother. The accusations were that he started calling her and later proposed marriage and forced himself upon her and took her to different hotels and later refused to marry her. The FIR was lodged on the statement of the girl. She had also made a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. but thereafter committed suicide.

No grounds for bail are made out. The second application was even otherwise is not maintainable as there are no fresh circumstances.
