The petitioners have filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.91 dated 02.05.2018 registered for the offence under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier the petition was filed for anticipatory bail, which was dismissed on merits vide order dated 13.09.2018 by this Court. In that order, the facts have already been discussed and it has been noted down that after occurrence, second FIR was again registered for causing injuries to the complainant and proceedings u/s 107/151 Cr.P.C were also initiated against them.

No new changed circumstances have been shown for grant of anticipatory bail. Therefore, finding no merit in this petition, the same is dismissed.
