In deference to order dated 12.03.2018, Jashandeep Singh Randhawa, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Karnal, is present in Court.

Affidavit dated 17.04.2018 of Mr. Jashandeep Singh Randhawa, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Karnal, filed in Court today, is taken on record subject to just exceptions. Mr. Randhawa states that he has recommended action to be taken against the concerned officer who now stands transferred to Yamuna Nagar. He further submits that due care and caution shall be exercised in future to ensure proper assistance to the Court.

The petitioner in this case seeks the concession of bail pending trial in FIR No. 488 dated 24.05.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A, 302, 201 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

It is informed by Superintendent of Police, Karnal that the petitioner is sought to be inculpated on the basis of call detail records of the mobile phone of the father of the victim i.e. the complainant. It was discovered that the present petitioner was in touch with the victim on the mobile phone of her father. Phone calls at odd hours from the mobile of the

petitioner were discovered to have been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks to withdraw this petition.
