DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.737, dated 10.11.2017, registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 363, 365, 379-B, 506/34 IPC, and 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at Police Station City, Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas his name was not mentioned. Neither any recovery has been effected from petitioner nor he was arrested on the spot. Learned counsel also submits that petitioner has not played any role. He is in custody since 11.11.2017. Out of total nineteen witnesses, ten have been examined. Co-accused namely Manohar Singh has been released on regular bail vide order dated 09.10.2018 passed in CRM-M No.14817 of 2018.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody period;

examination of ten witnesses out of total nineteen witnesses and also the fact that co-accused Manohar Singh has been released on regular bail.

Heard arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner as well as perused the contents of the FIR and other documents on the file.

Admittedly, co-accused Manohar Singh has been released on regular bail and petitioner is in custody for the last approximately one year. All material witnesses have been examined and also that the trial of the case may take long time to conclude and no purpose would be served by keeping him in custody when co-accused has been released on regular bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
