Petitioner, who is the father of deceased-Ahmadjan, has filed the present petition asserting that FIR was registered at his behest i.e. FIR No.0329 of 2017 dated 29.08.2017 under Section 304 IPC against three accused but during investigation, the investigating agency has deleted Section 304 IPC and instead included Section 304-A IPC while discharging accused Nitin and Dharamraj respondents 3 and 4 respectively. Counsel contends that when the petitioner found that the investigating agency is not properly conducting the investigation, he filed a representation dated 25.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, District Nuh at Mewat, but no action has been taken till date.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to Superintendent of Police, District Nuh at

Mewat-respondent No.2, to look into the representation of the petitioner and supervise the investigation.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Mewat, District Mewat-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 25.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
