This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station, Bathinda, District, Bathinda vide F.I.R No. 63 dated 9.7.2015.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 6.12.2017, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 6.12.2017 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
