C.M. is allowed subject to just exceptions. Filing of original copy of the settlement agreement dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-20) is dispensed with and legible copy of vernacular of the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise/settlement has been entered into between the parties dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-20) and, therefore, the petitioner be granted the

concession of bail as the complainant, in the light of the compromise, has no objection to the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail, however, with a rider that the complainant may be given a liberty to approach the Court for cancellation of bail, in case the petitioner does not fulfil the terms and conditions of the agreement/settlement dated 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-20).

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, also does not dispute the fact that as of now, there is an agreement/settlement between the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the dispute between the parties was primarily relatable to some money transaction, which has been amicably settled for now, the present petition is allowed.

The petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail subject to the satisfaction of ASDJM, Amloh. Liberty is, however, granted to the complainant and the State to approach this Court, in case the petitioner violates the terms and conditions of the agreement for cancellation of the concession, as granted.
