This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 35 dated 21.04.2018, registered under Sections 307, 324, 323 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have compromised the matter and the petitioner has already filed a petition, bearing CRM-M-44912-2018, for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise, in which, on directions of this Court, the parties have already got recorded their statement before the trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate on 10.10.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that even co-accused Tony Singh @ Ravinder Singh has already been granted concession of regular bail, vide order dated 12.09.2018, passed by this Court in CRM-M-34602-2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that

petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.05.2018 and he is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position. As per custody certificate, filed in Court today, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the facts that petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.05.2018; the matter has already been compromised between the parties and co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court as noticed above, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
