The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 01.08.2018, registered under Sections 379-B(2) read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

It is contended by learned Counsel for the petitioner that neither the petitioner is named in the FIR nor any recovery has been effected and challan has been presented before the trial Court and charges have already been framed and case is pending for trial.

Custody certificate of the petitioner has been produced in Court today is taken on record, a perusal of which shows that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and he is in custody since 18.08.2018. Admittedly, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been submitted against the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

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Although, the allegations of snatching an amount of ₹ 8 lacs were against the co-accused Jaswant Singh and recovery of ₹3,000/- was effected from the petitioner.

In view of the above factual position that trial will take long time to conclude finally, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars and thus, it would be just and appropriate if the concession of bail is granted to the petitioner. Therefore, this petition is accepted and petitioner- Inderjit Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court / Duty Magistrate concerned.
