SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is accused in cross-version in F.I.R. No.188, dated 23.09.2011, under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Saddar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of cross-version in F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Compromise (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the

parties. The Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, vide report dated 08.01.2018, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. In view of the report of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543*** and ***“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainants has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/ accused person.

[4]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. Cross-version in F.I.R. No.188, dated 23.09.2011, under Sections 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Saddar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioner.
