In the instant petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner seeks his release on anticipatory bail in case FIR No.64 dated 9th July, 2017, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

The petitioner was originally on bail but absented from

the proceedings on 15th November, 2017. He claims to have fallen sick on that date. On his absence, non-bailable warrant of arrest was issued against him.

In view of the circumstances mentioned in the petitioner's application, the matter is disposed off with a direction upon the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court concerned within 07 days from today, after which his fresh prayer for bail may be considered by the Ld. Court below.

Operation of the impugned order is stayed till 22nd January, 2018, after which this order shall automatically stand vacated.
