Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 22.05.2018 under Section 392 IPC and Section 120-B IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recovery effected from the possession of the petitioner is two bags of thread, each bag containing 60 kg of thread and the petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2018.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the contention raised on behalf of the petitioner. He has produced a photocopy of the bill to substantiate the fact that the usual rate of thread is Rs.100/- per kg.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the tentative cost of the thread comes to Rs.12,000/- only and the petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2018 and trial in the case will take sufficiently long time and no useful purpose will be served to keep the petitioner in custody, I deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
