The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.143 dated 18.06.2018 registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar under Sections 114, 115, 147, 148, 307, 323, 324, 328 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 23.6.2018. The investigation is complete and the challan has been presented. However, the examination of PWs has not yet commenced and, therefore, the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and, thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

Keeping in view the fact that the investigation is complete and that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, as well as the fact that the petitioner does not have any other criminal case pending against him, no useful

purpose would be served by keeping him in custody indefinitely.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and petitioner-Vicky is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned.
